Travel

•Pre 2020, **29** staff used transport to travel to **40** meetings on 186 occasions

Post 2020, staff attended meetings remotely via MS Teams

•15% reduction in use of all mouth mirrors. 18% reduction in use of single use mirrors. 58% planning to move away from mirror use.

Some boards have local recycling processes

Recycling is new to some areas whilst it has been in place for many years in a few boards.

Energy

- •21% increase in number of electric vehicles used by boards.
- 69% of boards planning to further reduce their use of fossil fuelled vehicles by March 2025

Waste

- •100% of fluoride varnish waste is now collected in orange clinical waste stream (8% increase)
- •We are working with NHS National Services to develop a nationwide recycling service for our toothbrush and toothpaste tubes.
